Eclipse

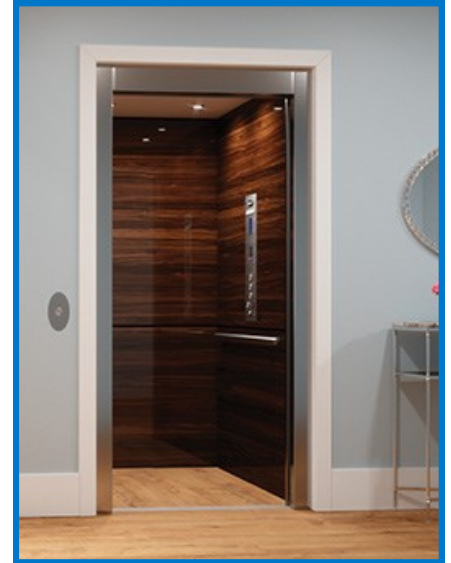

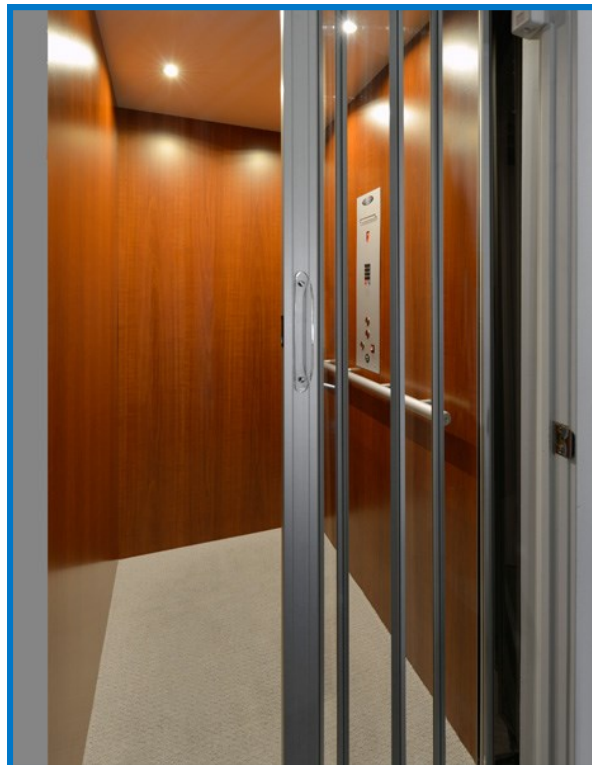

With the selection of the standard melamine cab walls, you'll have six different color options to choose from. The elevator cab walls can come with a matching ceiling, but white is standard.

A flat MDF cab suitable for painting or other on-site trim is also a standard option.

MDRF - Routed & Lacquered

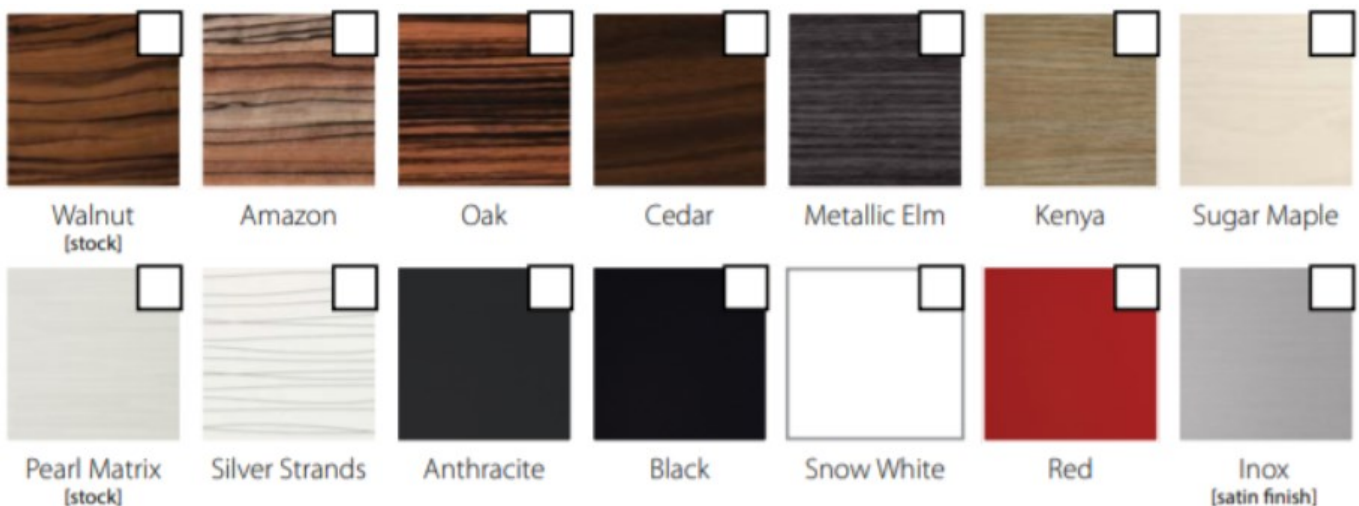
An MDRF cab offers you a raised panel look, at a fraction of the cost. The MDRF cab is available in a lacquered white finish.



Luxury MDF

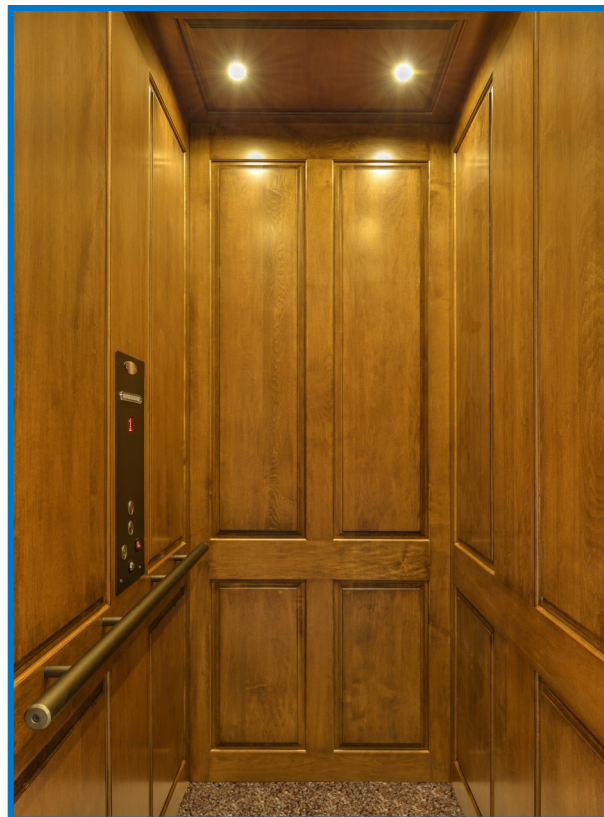

Luxury MDF wall and ceiling color options

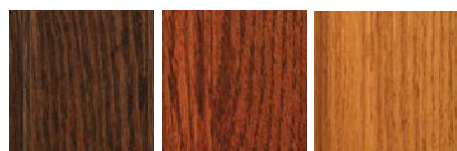


Wood Panels

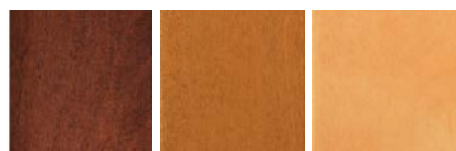

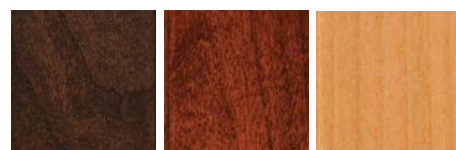

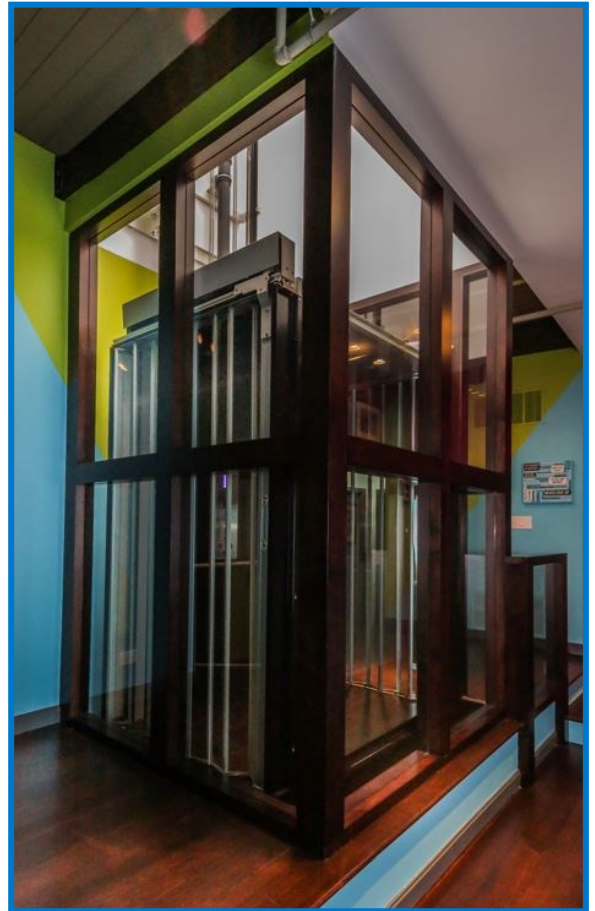

Glass or Mirror

Give your elevator a modern look with interior cab mirrors or a glass style cab. The standard mirror style cab comes with half wall mirrors on each wall. With a glass style cab, you'll have a luxurious addition to your home and your elevator will have more of an open feel to it. You can choose from a half or full wall window, or go with an all glass cab.



Cab Gates:

Elevator Gates -- Connected to the elevator cab, the gate travels with the elevator and opens when the elevator arrives at the designated floor. Choose from the following gate options:

- **Bi-Fold Gate:** Operates automatically like a bus door and is available in white and stainless steel
- **Accordion Gate:** Opens and closes to the side and is sold with an automatic gate operator for convenience. Available in a variety of materials/colors, including aluminum, vinyl, and acrylic.
- **Auto-Slim Gate:** Commercial style sliding gate that opens automatically. Can be used with either an auto-slim landing door or swing landing door. Available in metal (white, black and stainless steel) or custom-color.

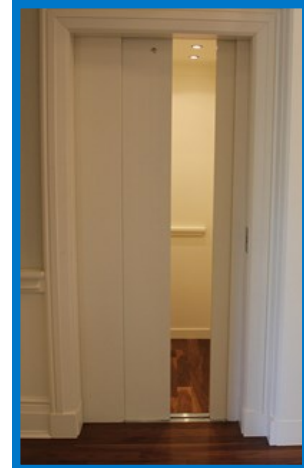


Bi-Fold Gate

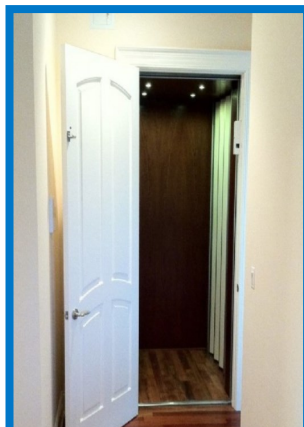

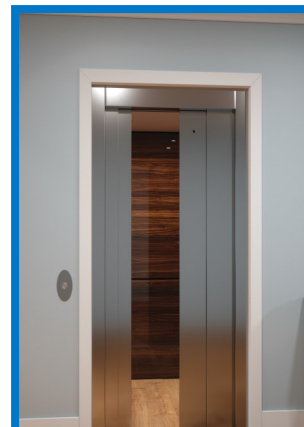
Landing Doors:

Landing Doors -- The elevator landing doors are attached to the structure of your home at each of the landing levels. The doors are "interlocked" with the elevator controls so that they will not open if the elevator is not present. Choose from the following door options:

- **Swing-Doors:** Provided by the general contractors, swing-doors generally match the other doors in the house. An electro-mechanical lock controls when it can open/close. Doors are generally wood but can be glass or metal if desired.
- **Auto-Slim Door:** Commercial style sliding door that opens automatically. Can only be used with an auto-slim gate. Available in metal (white, black and stainless steel) or glass.

Bi-Fold Gates

A bi-fold style gate operates like a school bus door, as it automatically opens when the cab reaches its floor destination. Bi-fold gates come in white or stainless steel and can be combined with swing style landing doors or auto slimline landing doors.



Auto-Slim Gate

The auto-slim gate is a commercial style gate that opens and closes automatically when the cab reaches a landing. An auto-slim gate can be combined with auto slimline landing doors or a standard swing style landing door.

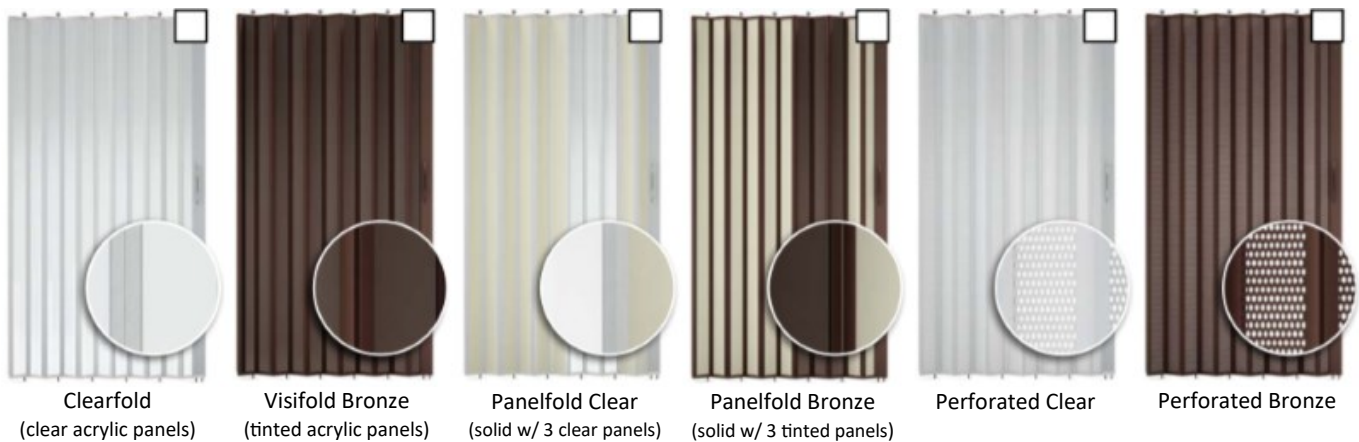


Accordion Gates

Accordion gates have solid panels that come in a few different color and finish options. To ensure safe use of your elevator, we always install accordion gates with a powered automatic gate operator.



Accordion Gates color/finish options



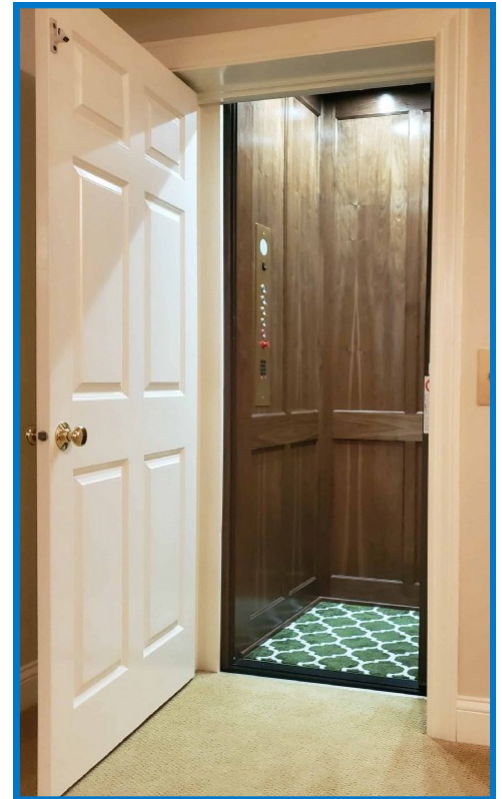
Swing Landing Door

With the selection of a swing landing door, you'll have the option of matching it to all of the other doors throughout your home. Typically, the swing door is purchased/installed by the general contractor. The swing door must be installed in compliance with the 3" x 5" or 3/4" x 4" elevator safety rule. EHLS will provide the interlocks for the landing doors.

Swing landing doors are available in:

- Wood
- Glass
- Aluminum

Slimline Automatic Landing Doors

Slimline automatic doors give your elevator a sleek look and are very convenient. With automatic doors, you won't have to worry about having to manually open and close the door when entering and exiting your elevator. Like a standard swing door, the slimline automatic doors must be installed in compliance with the 3" x 5" or 3/4" x 4" elevator safety rule.

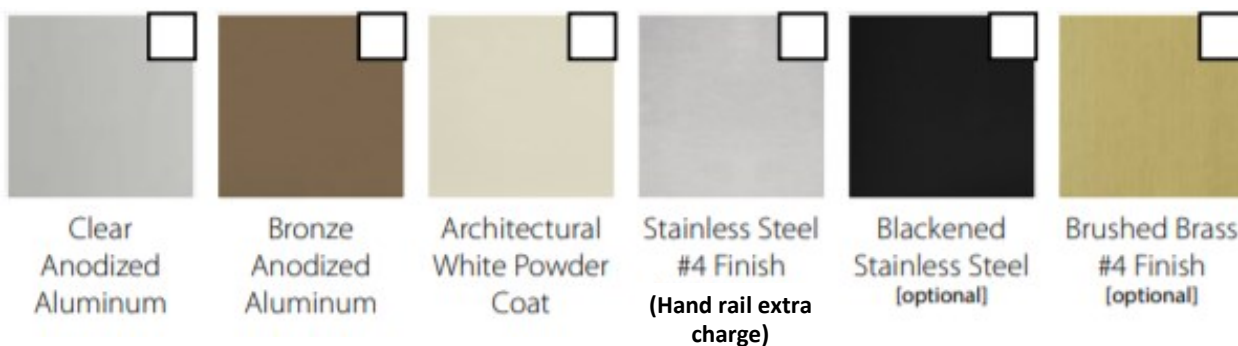


Hardware Finish Package & Color Options

Door Frames for Swing Doors

Similar to any wooden door throughout a house, an elevator swing door must be encompassed by a wooden door frame. The frame for your elevator can be matched to the wood species of your elevator interior or the other door frames throughout your home.
